

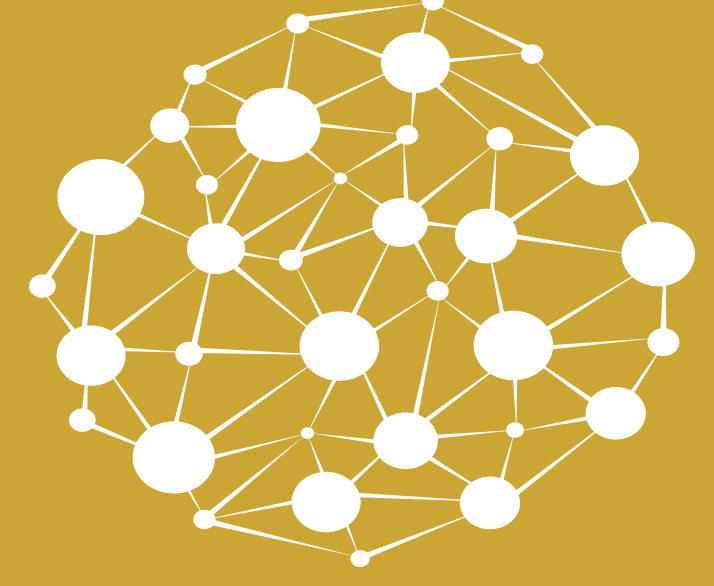

**Heidelberg University:** Complete a bachelor's degree (in any major) in four years and with a 3.0 GPA and you are eligible to stay and earn an **MBA tuition-free.**

Start college with credits that you earned in high school.

Paid internships and work co-ops lead to money in your pocket and career opportunities after college.

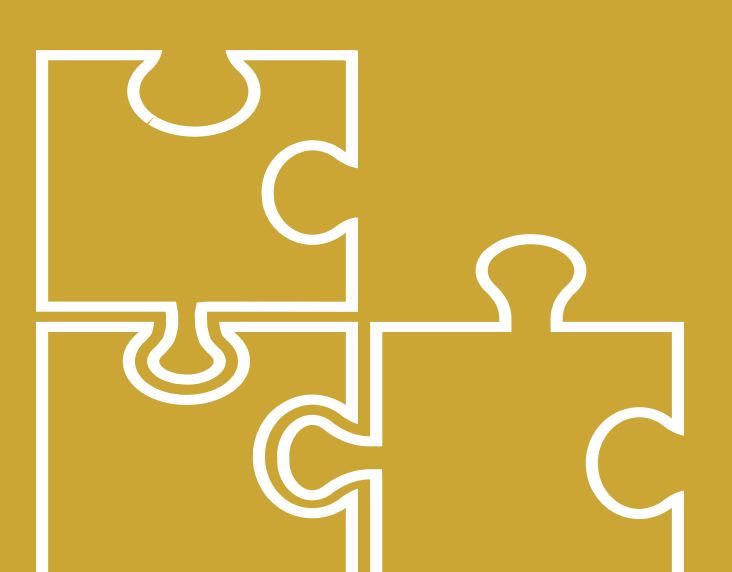

**Game Design:** Columbia College of Art and Design

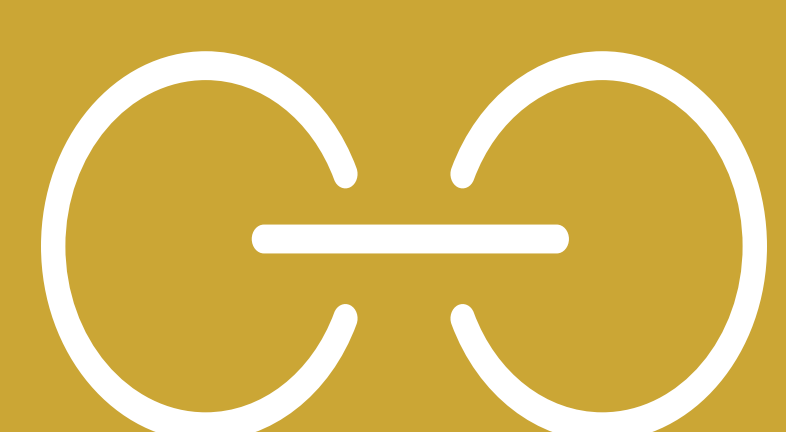

#### Identify transfer opportunities.



More than **21,000** California students transferred to out-of-state and in-state private colleges last year.

**Massachusetts College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences:** "Accelerated" and "Fast Track Programs" for transfer students

**Woodbury University:** Domestic applicants are eligible for a Transfer Scholarship of \$12,000-\$14,000.

#### Find tuition "deals."



**Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE)**

Eligible students pay no more than **150 percent** of that institution's resident tuition rate.

Average savings per student: \$9,692
